- A. All exhibits will be judged face-to-face, Monday of Fair, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with a break at 2:30 p.m. The Youth Building will be open at 10:00 a.m. Numbers will be available at 10:45 a.m. After judging is finished, the building will close. Judging will take place in the 4-H Youth Building.
- B. A maximum of five (5) items / styles per exhibitor may be exhibited per division, but no more than one exhibit per class number.
- C. Projects entered at this year's Racine County 4-H Communications and Arts Festival (CPAF) may also be entered at this year's Racine County Fair. Entries from previous year's CPAF will not be accepted.
- D. Any paper item, including creative writing pieces, measuring 8 ½" x 11" or smaller must be in a protective plastic sleeve or folder.
- E. Posters or panels must not exceed 22" x 28" in size.
- F. Punch a hole in the upper right-hand corner of your project to affix the entry tag.
- G. Wi-Fi access will be available for judging; however, the exhibitor must supply a computer or tablet for viewing applicable entries.

**Division 1 – Spoken Word**

- A. Speeches, demonstrations, and other verbal entries may be recorded **OR** live and **MUST INCLUDE A PHYSICAL EXHIBIT TO BE DISPLAYED AT THE FAIR** (poster, program, written summary, outline, notecards, photo montage, etc.). Please consider the following time guidelines:
  - a. 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Grade: 2 – 7 Minutes
  - b. 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> Grade: 4 – 9 Minutes
  - c. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade and older: 6 – 12 Minutes
  - d. Team Demonstrations Time limit will be determined by the oldest participant.
- B. Apart from dramatic readings, theatric / dramatic and musical entries will **NOT** be accepted. These exhibits should instead be entered in Dept 18 (Junior Class Cultural Art) under Divisions 9 (Drama) or 10 (Music)

- C. Entry should sell the observer on taking action.
