- A. All exhibits will be judged face-to-face, Monday of Fair, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with a break at 2:30 p.m. The Youth Building will be open at 10:00 a.m. Numbers will be available at 10:45 a.m. After judging is finished, the building will close. Judging will take place in the 4-H Youth Building.
- B. A maximum of three (3) different entries per exhibitor may be exhibited per division, but not more than one per class.
- C. Displays are 3-Dimensional, 18" x 24" in size and include articles to assist in explaining what you have accomplished. A poster should be 14" x 22" in size.
- D. You need to be enrolled in the Youth Leadership project (must be a junior or teen leader) OR the Self-Determined project.
- E. Any items intended for hanging should have 2 holes punched near the top or other applicable hanger affixed to the back.
